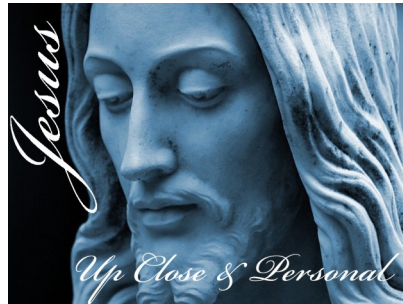
Kenbrook Bible Camp News

SOLID TRUTH: A TEACHABLE SPIRIT

"All this I have spoken while still with you, but the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."

John 14:27-28

The gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John) record "all that Jesus began to do and to teach until the day he was taken up to heaven," (Acts 1). Those four books are where we find Jesus' intimate teachings with his disciples as well as his teachings to the crowds that followed him. We also see the personal times he spent with friends such as Mary, Martha and Lazarus. As he speaks the words in John, he is "teaching" his disciples about the time when he will return to the Father in heaven and will no longer have the one on one contact with them. He is assuring them that they will not be alone or abandoned by him but that his very own Spirit will come and teach them and lead them into all truth.

Can we pause and ask ourselves today...

"HOW TEACHABLE AM I?"

In that same passage in John (14:22-24), Jesus says this: "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him and will come to him and make our home with him. He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me."

What is the danger in not having a teachable spirit and obeying his teaching?

Paul tells us in I Timothy 4 that our conscience can actually become seared and we stand in danger of "abandoning the faith and following deceiving Spirits and things taught by demons."

WOW! He knew we would never make it on our own.

He sent his Spirit to:

"Guide you into ALL TRUTH!"

What a powerful gift!

Father, I need your Spirit to know you better;
to discern teaching; to know your mind.

I need to your Spirit to follow you.
